- 1 The Liquor Licensing Regulation, Manitoba Regulation 177/94, is amended by this regulation.
- 2(1) Subsection 14(4) is amended in the part after clause (c) by striking out everything after "to produce" and substituting "one of the authorized types of identification set out in subsection (4.1)".
- 2(2) The following is added after subsection 14(4):
- **14(4.1)** A person who is required to produce identification under subsection (4) must produce one of the following types of identification that belong to the person:
 - (a) a valid passport;
 - (b) a valid driver's licence or identification card issued by Manitoba Public Insurance:
 - (c) two valid pieces of government-issued identification, with at least one piece of identification containing a photograph of the person.
- **2(3)** Subsection 14(5) is amended by striking out "identification under subsection (4)" and substituting "a type of identification set out in subsection (4.1)".

2(4) Subsection 14(6) is amended by striking out "the identification required under subsection (4)" and substituting "a type of identification set out in subsection (4.1)".
