## Manitoba Regulation 177/94 amended

- 1 The Liquor Licensing Regulation, Manitoba Regulation 177/94, is amended by this regulation.
- 2(1) Subsection 28(1) is amended by striking out everything after clause (c).
- 2(2) The following is added after subsection 28(1):
- **28(1.1)** The type of live entertainment provided by a cabaret licensee must be acceptable to the commission. Live musical performances, comedians, musical theatre performances and the live performance of original mixed music by a disc jockey would be acceptable forms of entertainment but the playing of pre-recorded music alone would not be acceptable.
- 2(3) Subsection 28(2) is replaced with the following:
- **28(2)** Unless otherwise authorized by the commission, a cabaret licensee must provide at least two hours of live entertainment in the cabaret each day the cabaret is in operation. The live entertainment must be provided
  - (a) between 12 noon and 8:00 p.m., on any day when the cabaret closes at or before 8:00 p.m.; and
  - (b) between 8:00 p.m and 2:00 a.m., on any other day.

## 2(4) Subsection 28(3) is repealed.

## Coming into force

This regulation comes into force on January 1, 2014.
