## Manitoba Regulation 128/98 amended

1 The Laying Hen Guota Order, Manitoba Regulation 128/98, is amended by this Order.

## 2 Section 1 is amended

(a) by repealing the definition "Temporary Quota Leasing Program"; and
(b) by adding the following definition:
"temporary laying hen quota adjustment program" means the program approved by the Board and designated with that name, as that program may be amended or varied from time to time.

3 The following is added after section 5:

## Temporary laying hen quota adjustment program

5.1 The Board may, upon application in a form acceptable to the Board, temporarily reduce or increase the laying hen quota allotted to an applicant in accordance with the procedures set out in the temporary laying hen quota adjustment program and subject to any terms and conditions that the Board establishes within the program.

[^0](a) if after any adjustments under Part IV the global allocation is estimated to 54.189 million dozen eggs or less in any calendar year, on a pro rata basis to reflect each registered producer's share of the global allocation at any point in time;

## Clause 7 (b) is replaced with the following:

(b) allotting a portion of the Overbase to the temporary laying hen quota adjustment program and the remaining balance on a pro rata basis to registered producers who applied for an increase in their quotas, subject to any terms and conditions established by the Board with respect to the increase.
