Group Life Insurance Regulation, amendment

Manitoba Regulation 187/2005 amended
1 *The Group Life Insurance Regulation, Manitoba*
Regulation 187/2005, is amended by this regulation.

2(1) The definition "eligible worker" in section 1 is replaced with the following:

"eligible worker" means a worker injured on or after January 1, 1992, who

(a) has been in receipt of wage loss benefits under the Act for more than 24 months;

(b) is receiving wage loss benefits at the time of their death, or dies within 90 days after the last day they received wage loss benefits; and

(c) is not entitled to life insurance benefits through an employer at the time of their death.

2(2) The following is added after section 1:

Exception — other life insurance

1.1 The following provisions do not apply to a worker who was injured between January 1, 1992, and December 31, 2021:

(a) clause (c) of the definition "eligible worker" in section 1;

(b) clause 5(b).

3 Section 5 is replaced with the following:

Benefit is payable to estate

5 A benefit payable under this regulation is payable to the estate of the deceased eligible worker on proof satisfactory to the board that

(a) the worker has died; and

(b) the worker is not entitled to life insurance benefits through an employer.

Coming into force

4 This regulation comes into force on January 1, 2022.
