#### Manitoba Regulation 187/2005 amended

1 The Group Life Insurance Regulation, Manitoba Regulation 187/2005, is amended by this regulation.

# 2(1) The definition "eligible worker" in section 1 is replaced with the following:

"eligible worker" means a worker injured on or after January 1, 1992, who

- (a) has been in receipt of wage loss benefits under the Act for more than 24 months:
- (b) is receiving wage loss benefits at the time of their death, or dies within 90 days after the last day they received wage loss benefits; and
- (c) is not entitled to life insurance benefits through an employer at the time of their death.

#### 2(2) The following is added after section 1:

## Exception — other life insurance

- **1.1** The following provisions do not apply to a worker who was injured between January 1, 1992, and December 31, 2021:
  - (a) clause (c) of the definition "eligible worker" in section 1;

(b) clause 5(b).

## 3 Section 5 is replaced with the following:

## Benefit is payable to estate

- **5** A benefit payable under this regulation is payable to the estate of the deceased eligible worker on proof satisfactory to the board that
  - (a) the worker has died; and
  - (b) the worker is not entitled to life insurance benefits through an employer.

## Coming into force

This regulation comes into force on January 1, 2022.
