Manitoba Regulation 61/2014 amended1The Liquor Licensing Regulation, Manitoba Regulation 61/2014,is amended by this regulation.

2 Section 1 is amended

(a) in the definition "Act", by striking out "The Liquor and Gaming Control Act" and substituting "The Liquor, Gaming and Cannabis Control Act"; and

(b) in the definition "entertainment venue operator", by striking out "Liquor and Gaming Regulation" and substituting "Liquor, Gaming and Cannabis Regulation".

3 Subsection 3(2) is amended

(a) by striking out "Liquor and Gaming Regulation" and substituting "Liquor, Gaming and Cannabis Regulation"; and

(b) by striking out "retail premises" and substituting "retail liquor premises".

4(1) Subsections 9.1(7) and (8) are amended by striking out "persons delivering liquor" **and substituting** "employees of the licensee who deliver liquor".

4(2) The following is added after subsection 9.1(8):

9.1(9) A licensee must ensure that all employees of the licensee who deliver liquor sold under this section do not deliver liquor to the purchaser more than 30 minutes after the licensed premises are required to be closed under the Act.

5 The centred heading before section 44 is amended by striking out "RETAIL PREMISES" and substituting "RETAIL LIQUOR PREMISES".

6 In the following provisions, "retail premises" is struck out wherever it occurs and "retail liquor premises" is substituted:

- (a) section 44;
- (b) subsection 45(1);
- (c) subsection 47(1).
- 7 Section 46 is repealed.

Coming into force

8 This regulation comes into force on the same day that The Liquor, Gaming and Cannabis Control Amendment Act (2), S.M. 2021, c. 51, comes into force.
