Minimum Annual Earnings Regulation

Regulation 201/2009 Registered December 18, 2009

Minimum annual earnings, 2006 - 2009

- 1 Pursuant to clause 117(a) of *The Workers Compensation Act*, the minimum annual earnings for accidents occurring
 - (a) on or after January 1, 2006 and before January 1, 2007, are \$15,600;
 - (b) on or after January 1, 2007 and before January 1, 2008, are \$16,640;
 - (c) on or after January 1, 2008 and before January 1, 2009, are \$17,220;
 - (d) on or after January 1, 2009 and before January 1, 2010, are \$18,370;
 - (e) on or after January 1, 2010, are as determined in accordance with the following formula:

 $A \times 40 \times 52$

In this formula,

A is the provincial minimum wage, as prescribed in the *Employment Standards Regulation*, Manitoba Regulation 6/2007.

Coming into force

2 This regulation comes into force on January 1, 2010 or on registration, whichever is later.
