- Failure to file Pension Fund Financial Statement under subsection 3.28(1) of the Regulation
- Failure to file Actuarial Valuation Report and/or Cost Certificate under section 4.15 of the Regulation
- Failure to file Termination Report under subsections 7.7(1) and clauses 7.7(2)(a) or (c) of the Regulation
- Failure to file Termination Report under subsections 7.7(1) and clause 7.7(2)(b) of the Regulation

Administrative Penalty must be paid in 30 days.

You are ordered to pay the penalty indicated above within 30 days after being served with this Notice. Make your payment payable to the "Minister of Finance", and include a copy of this Notice. Do not send cash through the mail.

Appealing an Administrative Penalty:

You may appeal this Administrative Penalty to The Pension Commission of Manitoba. You must send your appeal to the Pension Commission within 14 days after you are served with this Notice. If you file an appeal within that time you do not have to pay this penalty until the Pension Commission decides the matter.
